Firearm Considerations for Concealed Carry

Open carry means the gun is visible to others. It is be legal in Washington, but ADTA doesn't recommend it. Local, state, and federal laws exist that regulate the carrying of a firearm. It is your responsibility to learn regulations where you decide to carry.

Concealed carry is the wearing a firearm on your body or within an accessory in your immediate possession where the firearm is not visible to others. The main purpose of CC is to have a substantial form of self defense with you when needed without drawing unnecessary attention. This lesson will provide you with a series of options and things to consider. Understand that there is no one-size-fits-all solution.


Safety First:

Always practice the FOUR BASIC RULES of GUN SAFETY. Watch ADTA Core Concept 1 video. When practicing drawing your firearm from concealment, the safety rules still apply!

Washington state regulations

- Open carry is allowed (no law against)
- Concealed carry requires a permit (RCW 9.41.050)
- WA CC is "shall issue" (RCW 9.41.070)
- Valid for 5 years from date of issue
- \$49.25 new; \$32 renewal




